Seneca County Farm Product and Agri-Tourism Guide Application

Farm Qualifications:

Your farm must be located in the geographical boundary of Seneca County, New York.

Plus answer “yes” to at least one of the following four criteria:

1. Does your farm produce or sell local farm products that are retailed directly to the consumer?
2. Do you complete sales with consumers at your farm?
3. Does your farm sponsor or host a farm market, roadside stand or farm store?
4. Does your farm sponsor or host agri-tourism or educational activities at the farm?

Note: Farm products sold in commodity type markets cannot qualify to be listed.

Example Farm:

Farm A is located in the Town of Varick and has a Romulus address. Farm A sells beef by the ¼ or half, seasonal vegetables via roadside stand, dry hay to individuals without limit to quantity, corn and soybean to a local elevator or broker, grapes to a local winery, wine made on farm, and decorative crafts made from farm products.

This farm qualifies to be listed in the guide. All products would qualify for listing excluding the corn, soybean, and grape sales. There are many sale scenarios existing on farms today so please do not hesitate to call with questions or clarifications. For instance in this example grapes produced on the farm are sold to a local winery. This scenario would exclude listing of grapes as a saleable product unless sale to the end consumer also exists.

A farm visit will take place after your application is processed to verify information and help answer any questions. A final copy of your listing will be sent to you via mail or email for your approval before inclusion in the guide. Cornell Cooperative Extension (CCE) Seneca County has the final decision on layout of the guide. Space may be limited depending on the number of final listings.
